

Galveston's Lost History: Graves, Ghosts and Glory with Dr. Paul Benson

NOTE Some streets within the Lost Bayou (San Jacinto neighborhood) district that are too narrow for a motor coach. Group will walk in these areas. Any guest not up to walking may remain on the motor coach awaiting the group.

6:30pm Dinner Fisherman's Wharf (full menu offered; each guest pays for their meal)

Hailed by *Texas Monthly* as the premiere restaurant of the Texas Gulf Coast, this Texas-sized establishment is the perfect spot to unwind while spending your day in Galveston. Ideally situated next to the Historic Strand District, you can enjoy the famous shrimp kisses, fresh red snapper, or the combination platter. Rooms boast of a splendid view of the harbor.

Although there is no senior menu, the group event manager is willing to let a few very light eaters order from the kids menu.
